What is Kumamoto Artpolis?

Kumamoto Artpolis is a unique architectural and cultural project initiated by Kumamoto Prefecture in 1988. We will preserve the diverse local culture and traditions nurtured in the rich nature, history, and climate of Kumamoto Prefecture, and create new cultures to pass on to future generations. The goal is to enhance people's interest in environmental design, improve urban and architectural culture, and create cultural assets that will endure for succeeding generations.

What is Kumamoto Artpolis Project ?

In the Artpolis project, the commissioner recommends architects with the appropriate skills and abilities from both domestic and international sources. This involves conducting design competitions to select the most suitable designers for the project. Designers proceed with the design through repeated communication with many people. The projects cover a wide range of public, both private and prefectural and municipal, and include not only buildings but also bridges, parks, and more. The Artpolis office supports the project owner and designers from the planning and design stages to construction and maintenance, and disseminates project information through publications and the internet.

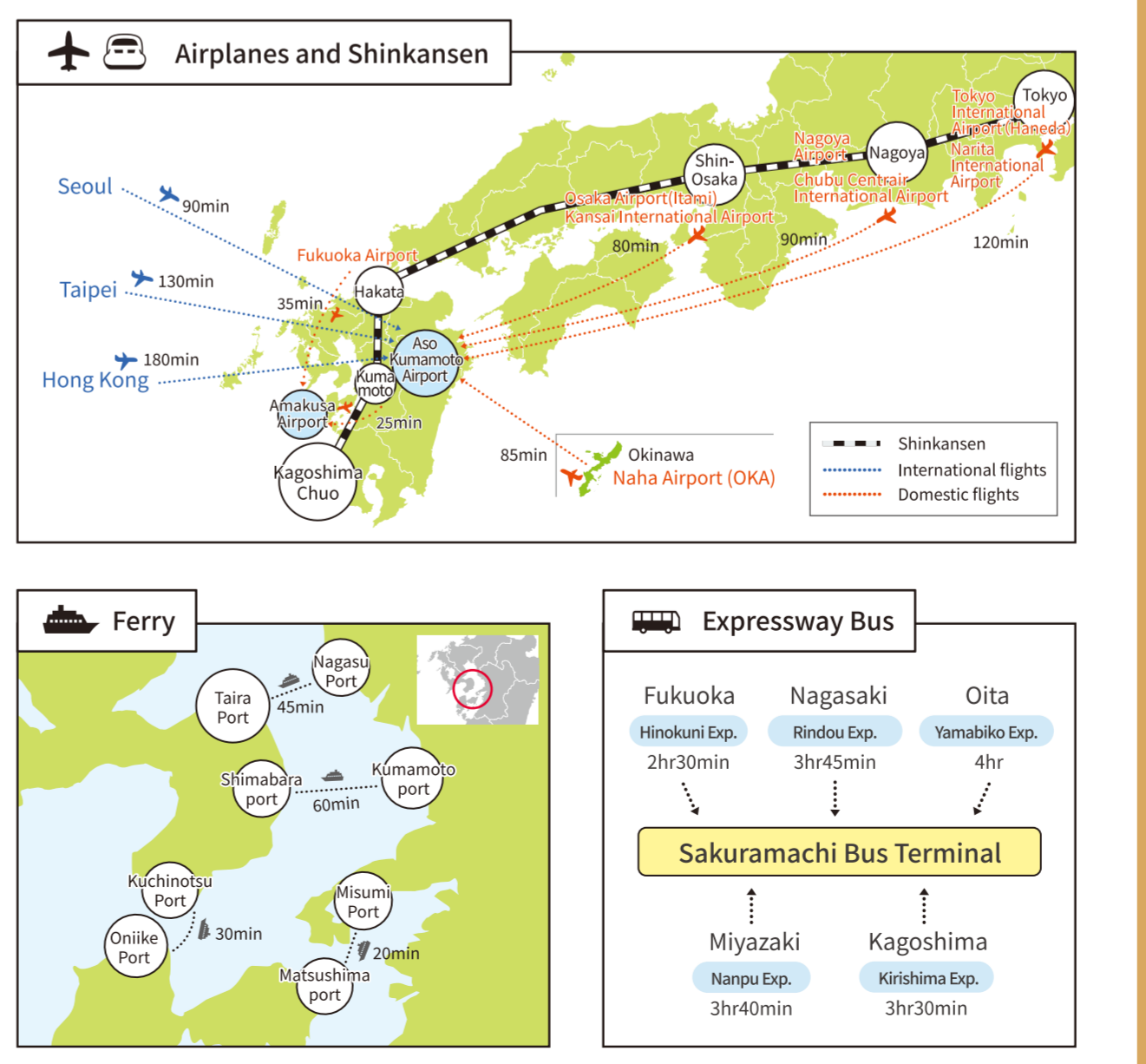

<The Straw Hat Pirates "Hino Kuni" Reconstruction Arc>

In April 2016, a series of powerful earthquakes struck Kumamoto prefecture. Following the quakes, manga artist and Kumamoto native Eiichiro Oda sent a heartfelt message saying he would "definitely help with the relief efforts." It was from this message that the "ONE PIECE Kumamoto Revival Project" began. Statues of the Straw Hat Pirates were installed in nine municipalities in Kumamoto to organized many projects to promote the reconstruction effort.

<STORY>

The Straw Hat Pirates made landfall in Kumamoto, the "hino Kuni." In this land, the pain of the locals and the extensive damage from the Kumamoto earthquakes is no secret, even today. Here, Captain Luffy instructed his nakama to help with the relief efforts, his nakama promise to reunite by his side once more as the set out to tackle the challenges in the affected regions with their unique talents.
