# Kumamoto Municipal Shinchi Public Housing Complex – Block B



#### **Architectural Outline**

The apartment buildings, which resemble a pair of whales swimming side by side, were given undulating facades and windows of different quality to create greater visual variety. The project was conceived as a theater, with the mall sandwiched between the buildings being the stage and the buildings being the seats. The toilets and bathrooms were concentrated in the middle of the housing units, enabling the more public spaces to look out over the mall. All stairs lead directly to the mall, assuring communication at every level: family, housing complex residents, and neighborhood. The "whales" head eastward, bearing a human community.
