#### Architectural Outline

Renovations in Europe are intended to give new life to old structures and to preserve accumulated memories. In this case we believed we should not simply renovate but instead make radical changes because the old library was not a historic landmark. The building's new image is a response and a gesture of respect to the grandeur and power of the stone walls of Kumamoto Castle which stands in front of it. In any case, what should this building be? Spanish? European? Japanese? Barcelona in Kumamoto? Barcelona? or perhaps Kumamoto?
