# Yunomae Cartoon Museum and Community Center



#### **Architectural Outline**

Yunomae Cartoon Museum and Community Center is a combination of an art museum dedicated to the late Ryosuke Nasu, a political cartoonist who came from this town, and a community center for social education. A corridor will eventually integrate the facility functionally with the adjacent Farming Village Environment Improvement Center. Surrounded by Ichifusayama Park, the site is in a beautiful natural environment. It is located in the center of the town near a terminus of the semi-public Yunomae Line. The five independent buildings relate to each other as fish in a shoal do. They are linked by function and by covered walkways. Local wood materials and skills were used. The aim was to create a new type of wooden architecture. Cantilevers were used in the structural systems of the main spaces.
