Architectural Outline

The Tsunagi Local Products Gallery and Megane Bridge Park were built on a site where the old Tsunagi Town Hall once stood, facing National Road Number 3. The area is scenic, surrounded by Tsunagi River, which is full of fish, the old Megane Bridge, and the hills of Maizu Castle Park. The local products gallery and Megane Bridge Park contain not just multipurpose facilities such as the welfare center and the culture hall but spaces where people can simply pass the time. The park, river, bridge and hills are linked in such a way that people in surrounding areas as well as Tsunagi citizens can enjoy themselves and relax there.
