Aso Police Station Uchinomaki Police Box



Architectural Outline

This koban consists of an office, an entrance porch and a meeting room arranged in a straight line in plan with light wells situated at both ends. The walls and the floor, both inside and outside, have been covered with randomly laid white brick tiles. A white tile was selected, not because it projects a bright image, but because it can become soiled in various ways and because countless black joints, which resemble hastily scribbled writing, proliferate over surfaces. It is hoped that over time these surfaces will become expressions of sincerity and continue to cover the interior and exterior spaces of this koban.
