Seiwa Local Dishes Restaurant



Architectural Outline

This restaurant is the third facility of Seiwa Bunraku Mura, next to Bunraku-kan (Bunraku puppet theater) and local-products center. Maximum number of seats available is 136 (includes 104 seats in the main dining, 16 seats in each 2 separate rooms.) It is connected to the local-products center with corridor. It was designed to be able to have Takigi Bunraku (puppet show with light supplied by bonfire) as a dinner-show inside in rainy weather. This is a wooden building with 88 locally-grown And its structure resembles to joints structure of timbers. bunraku puppet called pantograph method. Canopy made of Teflon which has high translucency is used for roof. Inside the building is a relaxing space with cedar timbers and soft light coming through the canopy. Outside walls are covered with transparent glass in order to have the view of surrounding nature. Light coming out from the inside creates soft and gentle atmosphere at night, which features this building.
